To further enhance security protection, InHand Networks has decided to adjust the initial login passwords for its router products.

To facilitate understanding, the following terms are defined in this statement:

Term	Definition	
Initial Password	The login password on the nameplate of the Router.	
New Firmware	Firmware that supports the new initial password rules.	
Old Firmware	Firmware that supports the old initial password rules.	
New Configuration	Configuration exported from new firmware.	
Old Configuration	Configuration exported from old firmware.	

#### 1. Initial Password Rules Change Description

#### 1.1 Old Initial Password Rules

The old initial password for the router was a fixed "123456".

## 1.2 New Initial Password Rules

The new initial password for the router will consist of an 8-character random string, including uppercase letters, lowercase letters, and numbers.

#### 2. Scope of Impact of the Initial Password Rules Change

This change will affect all router products manufactured by InHand Networks.



## 4. Upgrade Instructions

- 4.1 Upgrading from Old Firmware to New Firmware
- a. If the router is currently using the initial password, it will remain as the initial password after upgrading to the new firmware and will revert to the initial password after a factory reset.
- b. If the router's password has been changed, it will retain the changed password after upgrading to the new firmware, but will revert to the initial password after a factory reset.
- 4.2 Downgrading from New Firmware to Old Firmware

Downgrading from new firmware to old firmware is not supported.

4.3 Upgrading from New Firmware to New Firmware

Upgrades between new firmware versions are supported.

## 5. Configuration Import Instructions

5.1 Importing Old Configuration into New Firmware

After importing the old configuration into the new firmware, the router will update according to the old configuration.

5.2 Importing New Configuration into Old Firmware

The old firmware is incompatible with the new configuration. Please avoid performing this operation. If this operation has been performed, please contact InHand Networks' technical support immediately.
